





Write  **Survival Manual**  
an instructional manual about how to survive in the wilderness from

Brian's point of view. Your manual should include at least six tips based on what Brian learned during his time in the wilderness. Be sure to fully explain each tip in multiple sentences, and include images for reference.


 **Character Profile**  
Create a one-page profile all about Brian. Include five character traits, three facts about him, two quotes, and one way that he changed throughout the story. Also include a visual representation of Brian. You may arrange your profile however you want.


 **Book Cover**  
Redesign the book cover to reflect the book, including illustrations, an enticing synopsis (one paragraph), a brief author biography, and a review (one paragraph). Your book cover must be different than the original.


 **Comic Strip**  
Create a comic strip that shows at least six important plot events. Each plot event should be in its own box, and each box should contain an image/illustration and text. Be sure to use plot events from throughout the entire book (not just one part).


# HATCHET CHOICE BOARD

Select **one** option to demonstrate your understanding of the novel. Be sure to include all listed requirements in your work.

 **Theme Poster**  
Create an inspirational theme poster for the book. Include a theme statement, a visual representation, and a quote from the book to support your theme statement. On a separate piece of paper, write one paragraph about the theme, with examples from the book.

Create a  **Playlist**  
playlist of at least eight songs for the book. Each song should correspond to a different plot event throughout the book. List each song, then write a detailed, multi-sentence explanation for each song that you chose.

Write  **Letters**  
two letters from Brian during his time in the woods. One letter should be to Brian's mom, and one letter should be to Brian's dad. Each letter should be from a different time in the story, and each letter should be at least one page in length.

Create a  **Map**  
map of the woods that shows where at least eight significant plot events took place. Include a label and illustrations/symbols for each map location. Also include a one-paragraph explanation of your map.
