Planning Methodology

Spencer residents were asked for input to develop the Town's 2024 Master Plan. Beginning in 2023 participants attended a visioning workshop, hundreds of respondents answered a survey and a community workshop was held. The data gathered was applied to the library's goals and aspirations.




Goals

1. Raise awareness of library services and events.
 - Use local cable station to reach non-library users
 - Partner with community organizations and local schools
 - Send library staff out into the community to conduct and promote programs and services
 - Market library services through social media outlets
 - Cultivate a sense of belonging and pride by encouraging interaction and engagement including volunteerism
2. Strengthen the library's role as a lifelong learning and cultural community center.
 - Offer programs to enhance learning, cultural awareness and pleasure
 - Display exhibits that promote visual and educational enjoyment in collaboration with local organizations and individuals
 - Digitize historic documents and photos
 - Increase open hours and access to historical museum
 - Provide a vibrant collection of library materials including print, media and technology
 - Arrange spaces to encourage exploration and creativity
 - Create and maintain an inviting, accessible and safe environment
3. Support and promote literacy for people of all ages.
 - Expand materials and programs for children that address early literacy
 - Work closely with community agencies to maximize diverse programming
 - Reinforce literacy with afterschool programs
 - Encourage interactive play



4. Take a leadership role in providing education and access to current technology.
 - Acquire and maintain latest technology
 - Increase staff competency in new technology
 - Teach the community how to use current technology
 - Circulate mobile hotspots to give patrons internet access
 - Lessen the gap of the digital divide by providing users access and instruction

5. Maintain and improve the physical space of the library.
 - Repair deteriorating interior and exterior areas
 - Update air conditioning system
 - Improve and update lighting
 - Acquire interior security system including cameras
